What's happening now in Neath Port Talbot?

Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council is currently consulting on the following:

Proposed Re-alignment Of Grwp Gwalia Residential Services Within Neath Port Talbot

This consultation aims to gather the opinions of interested parties on proposed changes to the location and configuration of beds for these forms of care. It is important to note that this proposal concerns Llys Y Seren Care Home in Baglan, Caewern Respite, Plas Bryn Rhosyn (the new care home being built in Neath on the site of Caewern Respite) and Dan Y Bryn in Pontardawe.

The proposed changes include: Short break (Respite) services - Relocating the short break (respite) services from Caewern Respite to Dan y Bryn and reducing the number of short break beds. Intermediate care services - Transferring intermediate services from Llys Y Seren and the existing Caewern to Plas Bryn Rhosyn Long term residential care services - Increasing the capacity for long term care beds in Llys Y Seren. The closing date for responses is Thursday 13th August 2015.

Digital By Choice Strategy Consultation

The Strategy proposes to increase the amount of online services available and provide better access for local residents. The strategy will also ensure that use of other, more traditional channels are appropriate, efficient and effective. The closing date for responses is Monday 17th August 2015.

What's happening nationally? Social Services and Well Being (Wales) Act 2014

The second round of consultations on the codes, guidance and regulations that underpin the Social Services and Well Being (Wales) Act 2014 has now closed. Work is underway to ensure that the Act will be fully implemented from April 2016. The Act will transform the way social services are delivered, promoting people's independence to give them stronger voice and control.

Draft Additional Learning Needs and Educational Tribunal (Wales) Bill

The draft Bill sets out proposals for a new legislative system for supporting children and young people, aged 0-25, who have additional learning needs.

Breast Test Wales will be returning to **Neath** from July to offer breast screening to women in the area. The mobile screening unit will be sited in **Tesco Neath Abbey Car Park, Neath** from **July 2015 until January 2016**.

Women aged 50 -70 years registered at: **Castle Surgery, Dyfed Road Surgery, Tabernacle Surgery, Skewen Medical Centre, Alfred Street Primary Care Centre, Victoria Gardens Surgery and Dulais Primary Care Centre** will automatically receive their breast screening invitations in the post, women over 70 can request appointments by telephoning the screening office on 01792 459988.

Please can you cascade the attached information to your networks and contacts?

Alongside breast screening, the other adult screening programmes include Bowel, Cervical and Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Screening. The links will take you through to our key messages.

Bowel Screening: Men and women aged 60 -74 are sent a home test kit to complete every 2 years

AAA Screening: Men aged 65 are invited for an ultrasound scan to check the size of their abdominal aorta

<u>Cervical Screening</u>: Women aged 25 -49 are invited for a smear test every 3 years, women 50 -64 are invited for a smear every 5 years.

Have you ordered and received your benefit form to complete?

Do you need support with filling it in?

Your form will have a "date to be returned" on it.... Get in touch with us ASAP once you receive it. If you delay in completing it by the date on the form you could be missing out on backdated payments.

Are you entitled to Carers Allowance?

Are you receiving the benefits you should be?

Have you received a letter about changes to your benefits?

Do you have any concerns or queries about the Benefit Reform and how you may be affected?

Did you know that you can now make a claim for Carers Allowance online?

The Department of Work & Pensions are now promoting this as a preferred method of claiming. It can be much quicker and easier to claim this way if you have access to a computer as:

- A paper form can take 7-10 working days to arrive after requesting one.
- If you require help to fill the form in you may have to wait for the next available appointment.
- The form then has to be posted back to the Carers Allowance unit which has the possibility of postal delays.
- When completed online the claim form reaches the Carers Allowance unit immediately.

If you need any help or advice in completing the online form you can contact the Carers Service we will be happy to help you, either by phone or if required, a home visit.
